

IMPORTANT NOTICE – ROAD CLOSURES

RE: NAGAR KIRTAN PARADE

SATURDAY May 28, 2011

The Nagar Kirtan Parade, also called Shobha Yatra, is a community parade that invites all faiths and community organizations to display their community spirit and join the Shri Guru Ravidass Sabha in celebrating their 4th annual parade in Burnaby.

Local businesses, community groups and families are encouraged to participate by walking along with the parade or in any other creative way that adds to the festivities on Saturday May 28.

To safely accommodate the needs of residents and participants, the following streets will be closed during these approximate time frames (see map).

Beresford between Randolph and Gilley (parade assembly)	9:00am – 12:00 noon 2:00 pm – 6:00 pm
Beresford between MacPherson & Randolph	2:00 pm – 5:00 pm
Gilley between Kingsway and Rumble	10:30am - 12 noon
Rumble between Gilley and Royal Oak	11:00am - 1:30 pm
Royal Oak between Rumble and Imperial	12 noon – 2:30 pm
Imperial between Royal Oak and Merritt	1:00 pm – 4:00 pm
MacPherson between Imperial and Beresford	1:00 pm – 5:00 pm
Dorset between Antrim and Sellers	1:00 pm – 5:00 pm

Parking along the parade route will be restricted to “No Stopping” between 9:00 am and when the road reopens.

Any towed vehicles will be towed to Mundie’s Towing located at 6983 Kingsway at Griffiths (604-526-9677).

We ask that you please modify your parking and travel plans to avoid the route should you need to travel in South Burnaby on Saturday, May 28, 2011 between 11:00 am and 6:00 pm.
